



Role Title:	Brush saw operator

This position is short-term 2-4 weeks beginning September 12, 2023 and ending in mid October. A total of 50 – 60 hectares of brushing and trail access is to be completed.

NOTE – Previous Experience is NOT mandatory, but is the pay rate is dependent on demonstrated prior experience. Instruction for new operators will be provided.

Key Saw Operator Role will include understanding and applying:

- Silverwood Safety Policies, safe work procedures and standard operating procedures
 - Diligent attention to safety of yourself and others
 - Participation in safety meetings and daily tailgate discussions
- Brush Saw operation
- Trail location selection – according to prescribed plans
- Tree planting spot criteria – use of obstacles (stumps, trees, shrub stems, logs) to shield trees from animal browsing and flood damage
- Site Preparation (trail access clearing) inspection – according to prescribed standards (maximum stump height, debris clearing, trail spacing, etc).

Key Saw Operator Position requirements include:

- Strong Attention to Safety
- Decision-making skills
- The ability to work well individually and as part of a team
- The physical ability to perform highly demanding role
- Preparation for work in all weather conditions in a remote setting
- The ability to carry 50+ pounds
- A good work ethic, a positive attitude & willingness to contribute
- Map reading skills are an an asset

Saw Operators are responsible for bringing all of their own personal items – clothing, gloves, footwear etc. Silverwood will provide brush saws for use on this project.
